ORDER:

The Hon'ble Minister (School Education, Youth Welfare and Sports Development) has announced on the floor of the Legislative Assembly regarding "providing and Laying of Synthetic Athletic Track at Nehru Park Sports Complex, Chennai at a cost of Rs.825.00 lakh."

2. The Principal Secretary / Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu in his letter read above, has stated that he has requested the Engineer-in-Chief to furnish a detailed estimate for the above said project. Subsequently, the Engineer in Chief (Buildings) & Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region, Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai-5 has submitted detailed estimate for Rs.8.25 crore along with drawings for Laying of Synthetic Athletic Track 4- lanes running track for 400mt and to provide synthetic track for other athletic games in D-portion of running track as per the topographical survey of the existing site / Nehru Park Sports Complex, Chennai.

3. Further, the Principal Secretary / Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu has stated that during the Infra review meeting chaired by the Principal Secretary to Government, Youth Welfare and

Sports Development Department on 21.10.2019 and it has been decided to engage a consultant for the above project and accordingly, necessary provision has been made in the estimate for the payment of consultant.

4. He has also furnished the detailed estimate prepared based on the Public Works Department schedule of rates for the year 2019-2020 pertaining to the Chennai city and local market rate approved by the Engineer-in-Chief (Buildings) and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region, Public Works Department and Chief Engineer (General), Chepauk, Chennai-5.

5. The Principal Secretary / Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu has requested the Government to accord Administrative and Financial sanction for Providing and Laying of 4-lane Synthetic Athletic Track including Sub base, Natural football turfing with sprinkler arrangements, High Mast lights at Nehru Park, Chennai at a cost of Rs.825.00 lakh.

6. The Government, after careful examination, accord Administrative and Financial sanction for a sum of Rs.7,33,50,000/- Lakh (Rupees Seven crore thirty three lakhs and fifty thousand only) for providing and Laying of 4-lane Synthetic Athletic Track including Sub base, Natural football turfing with sprinkler arrangements, High Mast lights at Nehru Park, Chennai with work wise allocation as details below:-

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para-6 above shall be debited under the following head of Account:-

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para-6 above constitutes an item of “New Instrument of Service”. The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Principal Secretary / Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next supplementary estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form ‘A’ appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. . The Principal Secretary / Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu is also requested to send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Final Supplementary Estimates 2019-20 to Finance (Edn-I) Department at an appropriate time without fail.

9. The Principal Secretary / Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu, on receipt of the cheque, shall deposit it in the bank in which the P.D.A/c is maintained, with a challan in triplicate, duly indicating thereon, the head of account “K Deposits and Advances (B) Deposits not bearing interest – 8443 00 Civil Deposits – 800 Other Deposits – CH Deposits of Sports Development Authority -801 Receipts – 02 Non-Bearing Interest (DPC 8443 00 800 CH 000D) (Receipts)”.
