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### **ORDER:**

The Principal Secretary / Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu in his letter read above has stated that the International standard sports infrastructure plays a vital role in achieving excellence in the world of sports arena. It helps in producing sportspersons of international standard as well as encourages the youth to participate in sports activities. World class sports infrastructure such as Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium, Nehru Indoor Stadium, Mayor Radhakrishnan Hockey Stadium and Nungambakkam Tennis Stadium were established for the VII SAF Games in 1995 of which, the Tennis Stadium, Nungambakkam comprises one centre court in the main stadium and six practice courts outside with floodlight facilities. All the courts are made up of Synthetic Surface as per International Standard. Chennai Open Tennis Tournament, Chennai Open ATP Challenger were conducted in a grand manner in this reputed stadium.

2. He has further stated that now the Stadium Officer, Tennis Stadium, Chennai has requested repair and renovation of the Tennis Stadium and also enclosed the letter received from Tamil Nadu Tennis Association (TNTA), Chennai wherein it has been requested resurfacing in the courts with International standard and approved brand materials. The Principal Secretary to Government, Youth Welfare and Sports Development Department has inspected the above stadium on 17.10.2019 and given instructions to submit the proposal for the renovation of the Tennis Stadium, Chennai, immediately.

3. The Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu has furnished the estimate prepared based on the PWD Schedule of rates for the year 2019-20 and local market rates for the items not incorporated in the schedule of rates and the estimate amount works out to Rs.210 lakh

4. The Principal Secretary / Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu has requested the Government to accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.210 lakh for providing the special repairs and renovation of the facilities at Tennis Stadium, Nungambakkam, Chennai.

5. The Government, after careful examination, accord Administrative and Financial sanction for a sum of Rs.88,18,709/- (Rupees Eighty eight lakh Eighteen thousand Seven hundred and Nine Only) and to utilize a sum of Rs.60,00,000/- from the provision made in B.E. 2019-20 with the Head of account 2204 00 104 AT 309 01 totally a sum of Rs.1,48,18,709 for providing the special repairs and renovation of the facilities at Tennis Stadium, Nungambakkam, Chennai as annexed to the Government Order.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para-5 above shall be debited under the following head of Account:-

**"2204-00 Sports and Youth Services – 104 Sports and Games-State's Expenditure - JW Grants to Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu for establishment of sports complex - 309 Grants-in-Aid-02 Grants for Creation of Capital Assets"**

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para-5 above constitutes an item of "New Instrument of Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Principal Secretary/ Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next supplementary estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Principal Secretary / Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu is also requested to send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Final Supplementary Estimates 2019-20 to Finance (BG-I/Edn-I) Department at an appropriate time without fail.

8. The Principal Secretary / Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu, on receipt of the cheque, shall deposit it in the bank in which the P.D.A/c is maintained, with a challan in triplicate, duly indicating thereon, the head of account "K Deposits and Advances (B) Deposits not bearing interest – 8443 00 Civil Deposits – 800 Other Deposits – CH Deposits of Sports Development Authority -801 Receipts – 02 Not-Bearing Interest (DPC 8443 00 800 CH 000D) (Receipts)".
